Our team believes in providing a safe and productive environment for our students. According to our latest Health Kids Survey, 95% of our students and 98% of our parents believe our campus is safe.

Our team has aligned this report card with our School Site Improvement Plan and will work next year on two focus-for-improvement goals: 1) increasing the number of students passing Advanced Placement tests with a score of three or better and 2) including career certifications in our Post-Secondary Plans.

***Career and College Readiness Student Outcomes***

Our staff believes that focusing on student outcomes is essential to preparation for Career and College. The area of 21<sup>st</sup> Century Skills includes the development of personal and social skills that will help our students' access career and college opportunities and keep them successfully engaged in life-long learning.

All students at Your High School begin developing a California Career Center (CalCC) Career Action Plan when they enter in the 9<sup>th</sup> grade. The planning process includes career exploration, identification of postsecondary goals, and the steps necessary to achieve them.

- 97% of our CTE students are members of student organizations,
- 100% of our students complete a basic job preparation curriculum,
- 78% of our student body visits a 2- or 4-year college in their high school career,
- 1,112 community college credits were earned by the graduating classes of 2011 and 2012,
- over \$1 million dollars in scholarships and grants were awarded to our students in 2012.
