Your Middle School has an exceptional staff that is dedicated to the highest standards of career and college preparation for all students. Our team believes in providing a safe and productive environment for all of our students. According to our latest Health Kids Survey, 95% of our students and 98% of our parents believe that our campus is safe.

Our team has aligned this report card with our School Site Improvement Plan and will work next year on two-focus for improvement goals: 1) increasing the number of students completing A-G courses and 2) increasing the number of students who complete career assessment inventories and a career action plan.

Career and College Readiness Student Outcomes

Our staff believes that focusing on student outcomes is essential to preparation for Career and College. The area of 21st Century Skills includes the development of personal and social skills that will help our students' access career and college opportunities and keep them successfully engaged in life-long learning.

All students at Your Middle School establish an account on the California Career Center (CalCC) and begin developing a High School Plan when they enter in the 7th grade.

- 77% of our students are actively engaged in extra-curricular activities on our campus,
- 81% of our students can identify three occupational areas of interest,
- 78% of our student body visits a 2 or 4 year college during their middle school years,
- our middle school culmination rate is 98%.
